

H1N1 Intranasal Live Vaccine and the Vermont Immunization Registry

- We're adding another vaccine to the grid: *H1N1 Intranasal Live*. This is the nasal spray formulation of the H1N1 vaccine that is licensed for use in persons aged 2 - 49 years of age.
- You can record ANY type of H1N1 vaccination by choosing *H1N1 – All Types*. But if you want to be able to distinguish between intramuscular and intranasal formulations when you look at the child's record, choosing *H1N1 Intranasal Live* when you have administered that vaccine will make it obvious at a glance.

WHEN YOU ARE READING INFORMATION FROM THE REGISTRY:

- A date in the *H1N1 Intranasal Live* field means the child received the nasal formulation.
- A date in the *H1N1 – All Types* field means the child received *some type* of H1N1 immunization. To determine which, click on the date. The ROUTE of administration field should show the formulation. If the shot was entered as “just the date,” you will not see this, and will not be able to determine which formulation was used– but most H1N1 immunizations administered in school clinics are entered with the formulation detail.
