Vermont Population Estimates

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This report was produced utilizing 2004 and 2005 data from the US Bureau of the Census and the National Center for Health Statistics.

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SUMMARY

This report contains Vermont census counts of population for 2000, and population estimates for 2004 and 2005. Population totals for counties and towns are presented (Tables 2 and 3, Figures 2 and 4). A listing of towns ranked in order of decreasing 2005 population is provided (Table 4). In addition, the age-sex distributions for the state and counties are given (Tables 5,6). Historical population data for Vermont counties are provided in Table 1. Housing unit estimates are no longer available in this report.

The population of Vermont was estimated to be 623,050 on July 1, 2005 (Table 1), up from the census count of 608,827 on April 1, 2000. This is an increase of 14,223 people, or 2.3 percent from the census. Net migration in Vermont from 2000 to 2005 indicates an overall in-migration of 6,768 people (Table 2). Net migration is calculated as the difference between population change and natural increase (births minus deaths). The highest growth rates occurred in Grand Isle, Franklin and Lamoille Counties (Table 2, Figure 3). In Grand Isle County the large percentage increase is in part a reflection of the small population. Growth was slowest in the southern part of the state, Bennington and Rutland Counties showing only slight increases, and Windham County showing a small decline in population since 2000.

Of the 255 towns and cities in Vermont, nine had total populations that exceeded 10,000 (Tables 3 and 4, Figure 2). These nine places accounted for 25.2 percent of the state's population. Ninety-one towns had resident populations less than 1,000 people, and three unorganized places in Essex County had no permanent residents (Avery's Gore, Lewis and Warner's Grant). Due to limitations in the data available for many towns, estimates may vary substantially from year to year. Observing the population trend for several years gives sense of the true population picture.

The fastest growing segment of the Vermont population is the 45-64 year old age group (Figure 5, Table 5). There has been a slight decline since the Census in the under 15 population, as well as in the 30-39 age group.

Population estimates by race and ethnicity for Vermont for 2005 are included in tables 7 and 8. These estimates are for the race and ethnicity categories used prior to the 2000 Census. Estimates utilizing the Census 2000 race and ethnicity categories are available from the US Census Bureau at www.census.gov.

The 2004 and 2005 estimates are a slight modification of estimates produced for the National Center for Health Statistics (NCHS) by the United States Census Bureau. An explanation of the modifications made to the Census/NCHS estimates is given in the appendix.

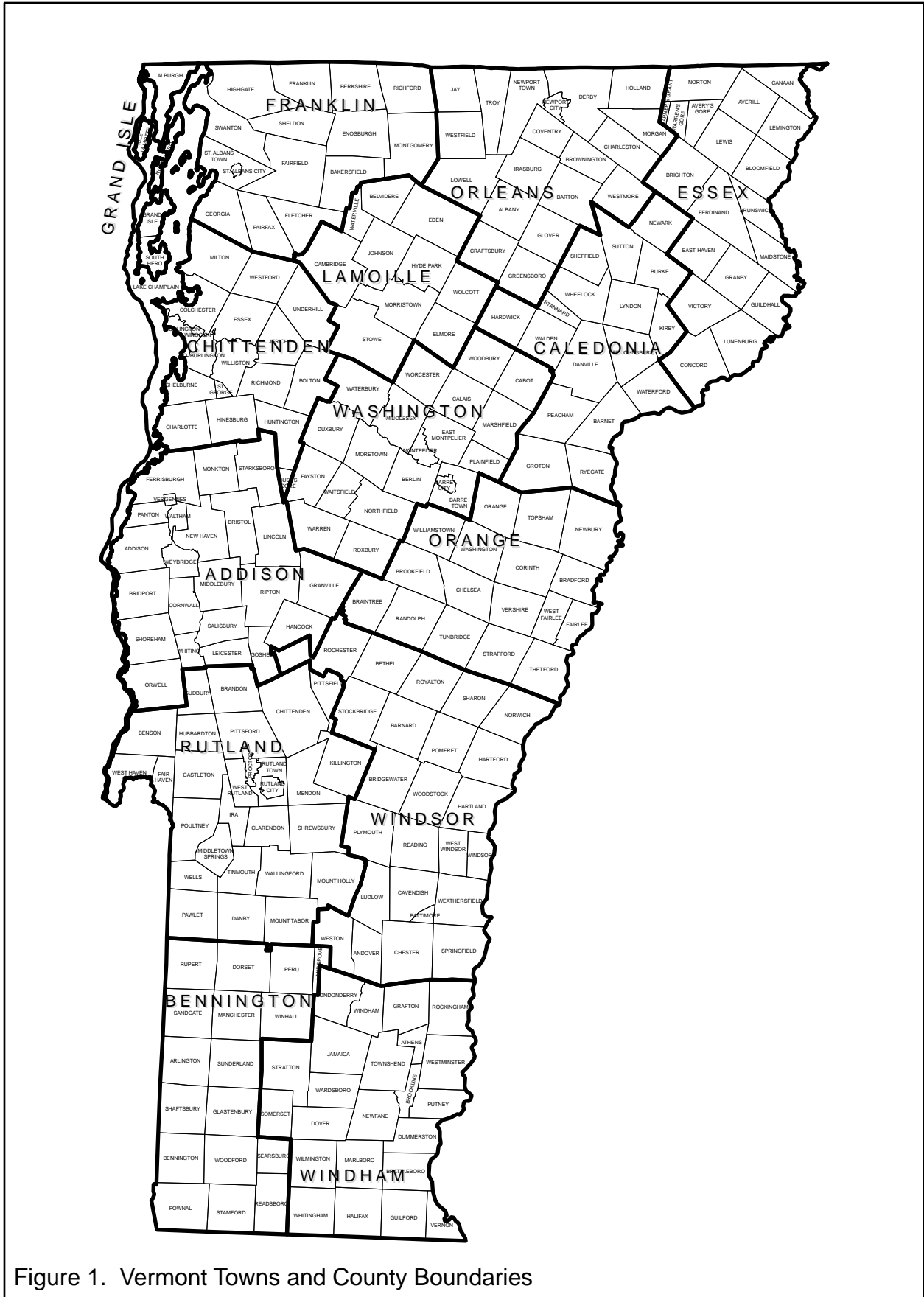


Figure 1. Vermont Towns and County Boundaries

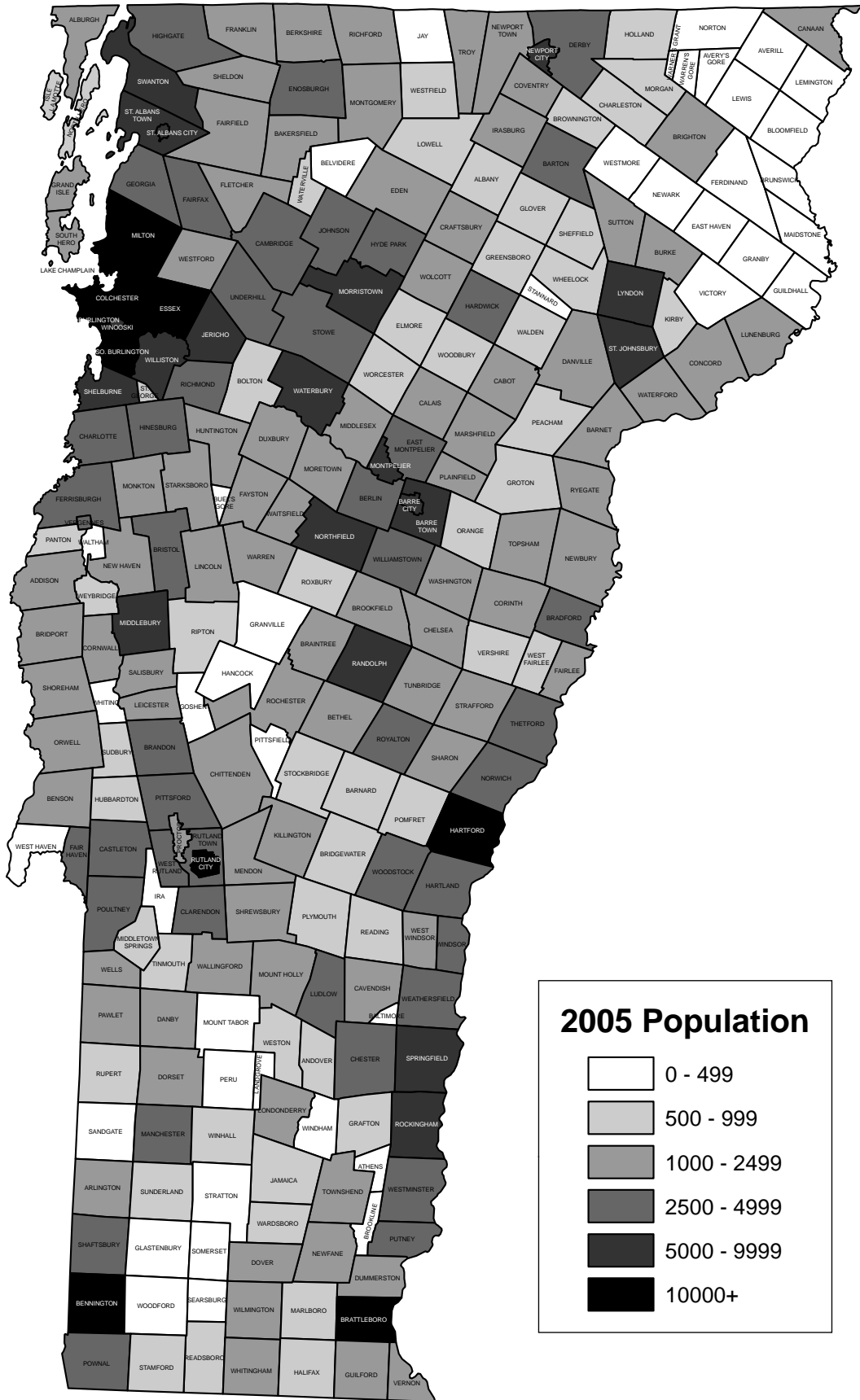


Figure 2. Population of Vermont Towns, 2005.

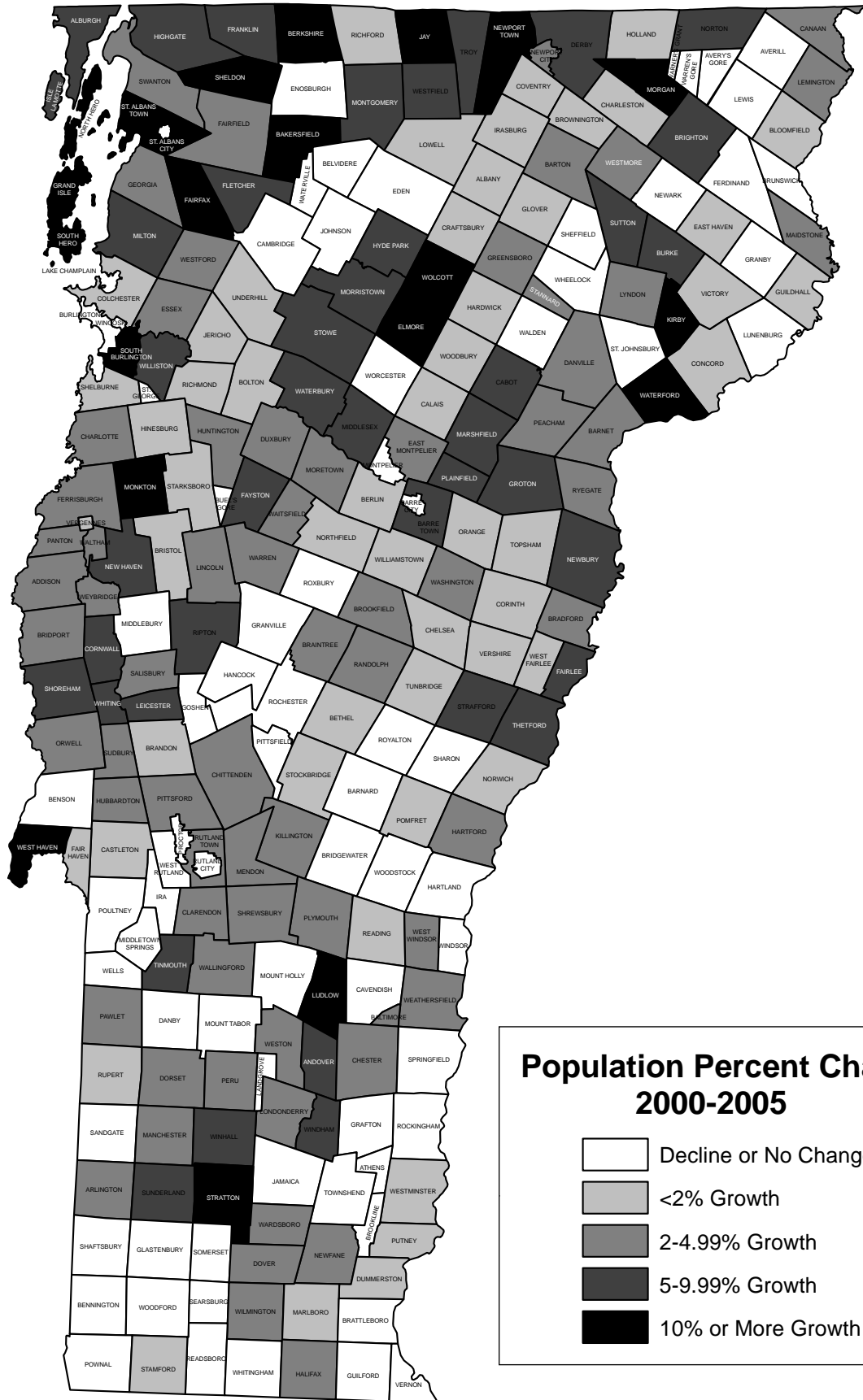


Figure 3. Population Change by Town, 2000-2005.

Population of Vermont Counties, 2005

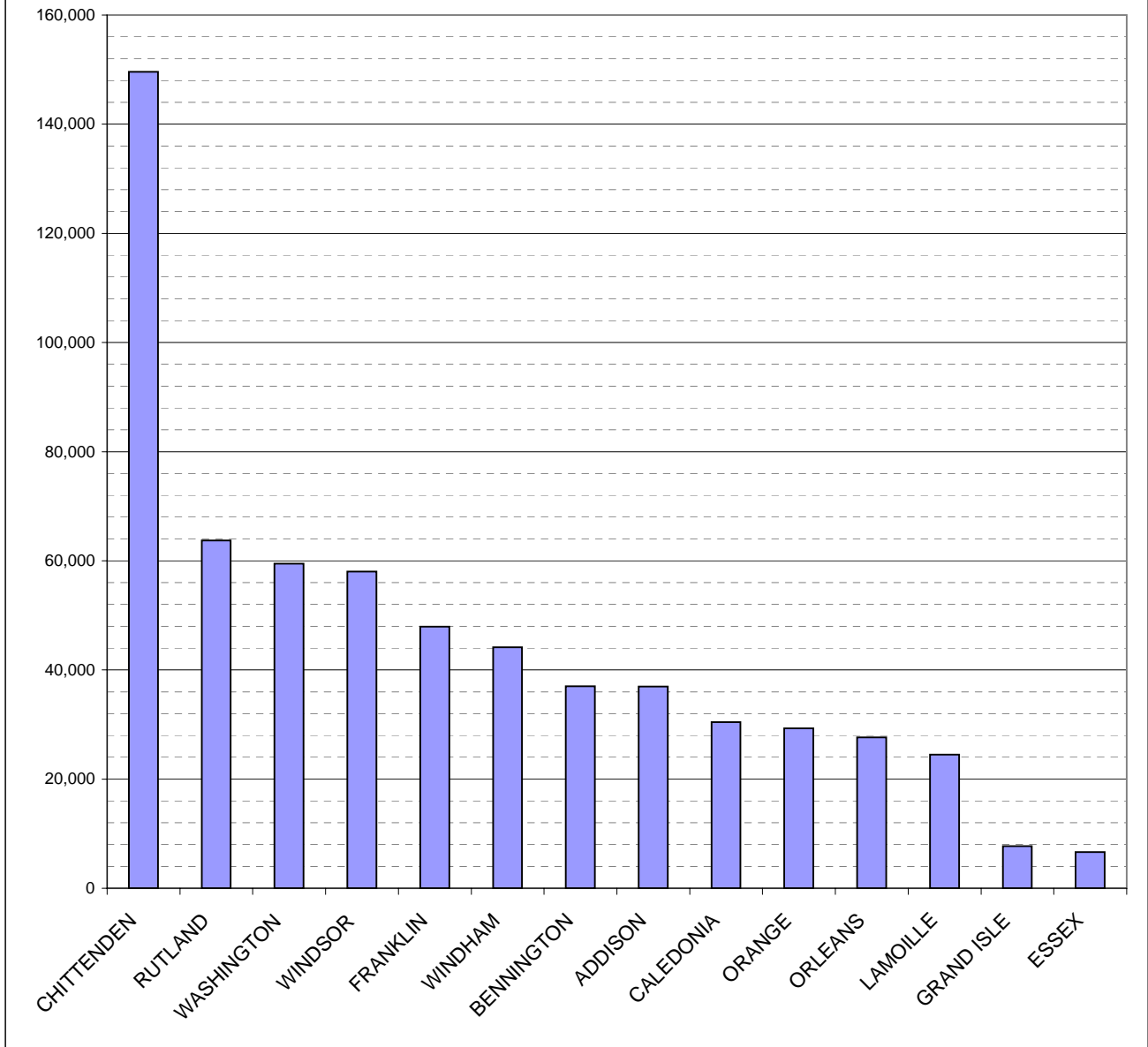

Figure 5. Population Age-Sex distribution of Vermont, 2000, 2005.

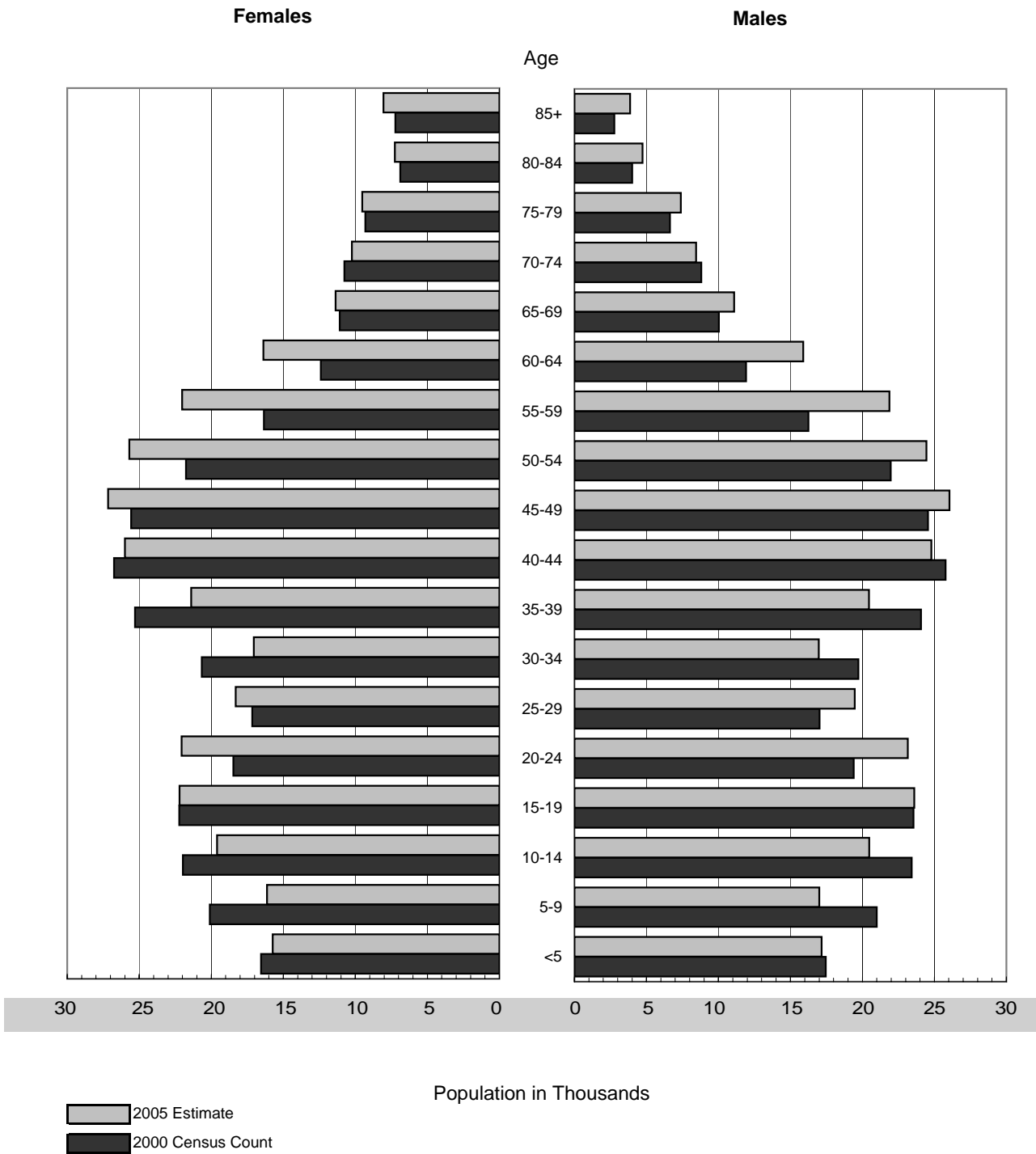

Race and Ethnicity Data

The following tables (7 and 8) are a slight modification of race and ethnicity estimates produced for the National Center for Health Statistics (NCHS) by the US Census Bureau. Census 2000 introduced a more detailed race and ethnicity categorization scheme than had been used previously, and subsequent estimates produced by the Census Bureau have used the new categories. NCHS contracted with the Census Bureau to produce estimates which bridge the new race and ethnicity categories back to the categories in use prior to Census 2000. In order to have consistent totals between these tables and the earlier tables in the publication, VDH modified the 2005 age group estimates in the original bridged estimates produced by the Census and NCHS. Estimates using the Census 2000 race and ethnicity categories are available from the US Census Bureau at www.census.gov.

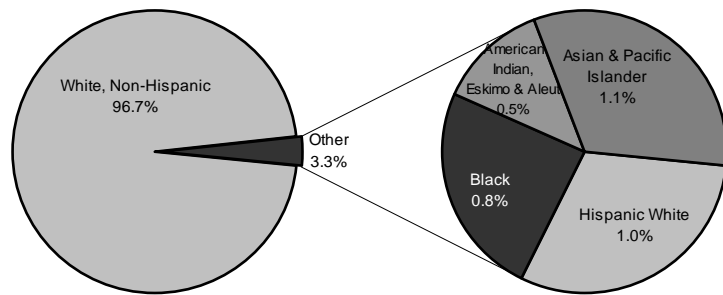


Figure 6. 2005 Distribution of Vermont Population by Race and Ethnicity

While racial and ethnic minorities are only 3.3 % of the Vermont population (Figure 6) , in general, these populations are growing at a much faster rate than the non-Hispanic white population. The non-white population of Vermont was 14,347, up 11.5% since July 2000. The number of persons of Hispanic origin was 6,769 in 2005, up 21.5% from July 2000. The white, non-Hispanic population of 602,370 is only an increase of 1.7% from 2000 to 2005.

The American Indian, Eskimo and Aleut population was the only race category showing a decline in recent years. The Asian and Pacific Islander population has increased 17.2% since July 2000, and the Black population of Vermont has increased

24.1% in that time. Hispanic origin is an ethnic category, so persons of Hispanic origin are included in each race category. Figure 6 shows only the white Hispanic population, there are a small number of Hispanic people included in each of the three non-white race categories as well.

The racial and ethnic minority populations in Vermont are heavily concentrated in Chittenden County. While Chittenden County had 24.0% of the total population of Vermont, 42.8% of the non-white population and 27.3% of the Hispanic population resides in Chittenden County. The lone exception being the American Indian, Eskimo and Aleut population, where Franklin County has the largest population.

It should be noted that the year 2000 populations presented in tables 7 and 8 are estimates as of July 1, 2000 and not the April 1 Census counts. Appendix

The 2004 and 2005 estimates in this publication are a slight modification of the Bridged-Race Postcensal Estimates produced for the National Center for Health Statistics by the U.S. Bureau of the Census.

NCHS contracts with the Census Bureau to produce the Bridged-Race Postcensal Population estimates, which collapse the original estimates using the Census 2000 race and ethnicity categories into the categories in use prior to Census 2000, making trends analysis possible. For this reason, it was decided that the NCHS Bridged-Race estimates would be used as the starting point for the estimates which would be published by the Vermont Department of Health beginning with the 2003 estimates. Because the estimated populations for the under 5 age group were not consistent with what VDH was seeing in the vital records (birth) data, the NCHS estimates were modified slightly, resulting in the estimates published here. An explanation of the modifications follows.

The number of births in a given year should be a reasonably good estimate of the under 1 population for that year, but the Census Bureau estimates of the under 1 population have not been close to this number.. For example, the number of Vermont resident births for the year ending July 1, 2003 was 6,506 while the Census/NCHS estimate of the under 1 population on July 1, 2003 was 5,861. This discrepancy prompted a closer look at the estimates for the youngest age categories and it was decided that VDH would estimate the under 5 population by county using vital records data. A detailed explanation of the methodology used for calculating the under 5 population is available from VDH by calling 802-863-7300. Because VDH estimates the under 5 population to be greater than the Census/NCHS estimate, some modifications were made to the estimates for other age groups so that county and state totals would be consistent with those published by NCHS. Because the Census/NCHS data utilize Medicare data for the 65 and older population, these were assumed to be the most accurate of the age group estimates and were not modified. Also, the 15-44 year old categories were left unchanged from the original Census/NCHS estimates because these were used in the calculation of fertility rates which were part of the VDH estimate process for the under 5 population. So, changes were made to the 5-14, and 45-64 year old age categories.

The town estimates for 2005 published here are those produced by the US Census Bureau, released June 21, 2006, with a minor exception. The Census Bureau estimated that one person lived in each of Lewis and Avery's Gore in Essex County. These places have previously been uninhabited, and VDH has received no compelling evidence to suggest that this has changed, so VDH continues to estimate zero population in these places and added those people to the largest neighboring town, Brighton.
